What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file sent from our website and stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone.

There are 2 type of cookies: persistent cookies, which are text files sent from the website and stored on your computer, and session cookies, which are only stored temporarily and disappear when you close your browser. This website contains both session and persistent cookies.
